- ✓ Provide us with a precise, well-focused question

- ✓ Tell us your objective

The more we know about the purpose and objective of the research, the better able we are to focus our approach. No need to worry that your ideas will be revealed to someone else. - ✓ Provide as much background as possible

We can be much more efficient if you tell us what you already know about the subject and with whom you've already spoken. That way, we will better understand the project and won't duplicate your efforts.
