PROCLAMATION
BY THE
GOVERNOR

TO THE PEOPLE OF KANSAS, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, The Kansas Leadership Forum is a statewide association whose mission is to serve and assist Kansas professionals and volunteers involved in providing youth and adult leadership education; and

WHEREAS, The purposes of KLF are to promote both youth and adult leadership education in Kansas as a key component to individual and community development; to enhance Kansas leadership education by establishing relationships for the exchange of ideas, information and research among participating leadership programs; to develop an environment that encourages the translation of leadership theory and research into practice; to encourage the creation of new educational partnerships between Kansas leadership programs; and to provide opportunities for personal and professional development; and

WHEREAS, the KLF accomplishes its goals through such activities as sponsoring an annual statewide conference, publishing a membership directory, establishing a clearinghouse resource center for distributing leadership material and information, sponsoring regional events for networking, planning and professional development, and publishing a newsletter on KLF activities and leadership development items; and
